AND 465TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURTS SERVING BASTROP COUNTY, TEXAS



It is therefore Ordered that the District Clerk of Bastrop County, Texas, shall file ¼ (one-fourth) of all civil law cases filed in the District Clerk's Office of Bastrop County in the 21ST District Court of Bastrop County, Texas, ¼ (one-fourth) of all civil law cases filed in the District Clerk's Office of Bastrop County in the 335th District Court of Bastrop County, Texas, ¼ (one-fourth) of all civil law cases filed in the District Clerk's Office of Bastrop County in the 423RD District Court of Bastrop County, Texas, and ¼ (one-fourth) of all civil law cases filed in the District Clerk's Office of Bastrop County in the 465th District Court of Bastrop County, Texas, on a rotating basis.

Any hearings or trials on such civil cases will be heard in the court where the case was originally filed. Any case originally filed in a Court that cannot be heard by the Judge of that Court because of recusal or otherwise may be heard by any of the District Courts serving Bastrop County.






