In order to confirm the existing policy of the County Court at Law of Bastrop County, Texas and the 21st, 335th, 423rd and 465th Judicial District Courts, and to clarify such policy, this order is being signed directing the District Clerk of Bastrop County, Texas, as to the procedure to follow in the filing of family law cases (except CPS and Juvenile cases) in Bastrop County, Texas.

It is therefore Ordered that the District Clerk of Bastrop County, Texas, shall file ½ (one-half) of all family law cases (except CPS and Juvenile cases) in the 465th District Court of Bastrop County, Texas, ¼ (one-fourth) in the Bastrop County Court at Law, and ¼ (one-fourth) in the 423rd District Court, Bastrop County, Texas, on a rotating basis. All CPS and Juvenile cases will continue to be filed in the County Court at Law of Bastrop, Texas. Any hearings or trials on such family law cases will be heard in the court where the case was originally filed. Any case originally filed in the County Court at Law of Bastrop County, Texas, that cannot be heard by the Judge of the County Court at Law because of recusal or otherwise may be heard by any of the District Courts serving Bastrop County. Any case originally filed in the 423rd or 465th District Courts of Bastrop County, Texas, that cannot be heard by the Judges of the 423rd or 465th District Courts of Bastrop County, because of recusal or otherwise may be heard by County Court at Law of Bastrop County or any of the District Courts serving Bastrop County.

This Order becomes effective immediately upon execution of the same by all Judges identified below and supersedes any previous orders affecting these matters.






