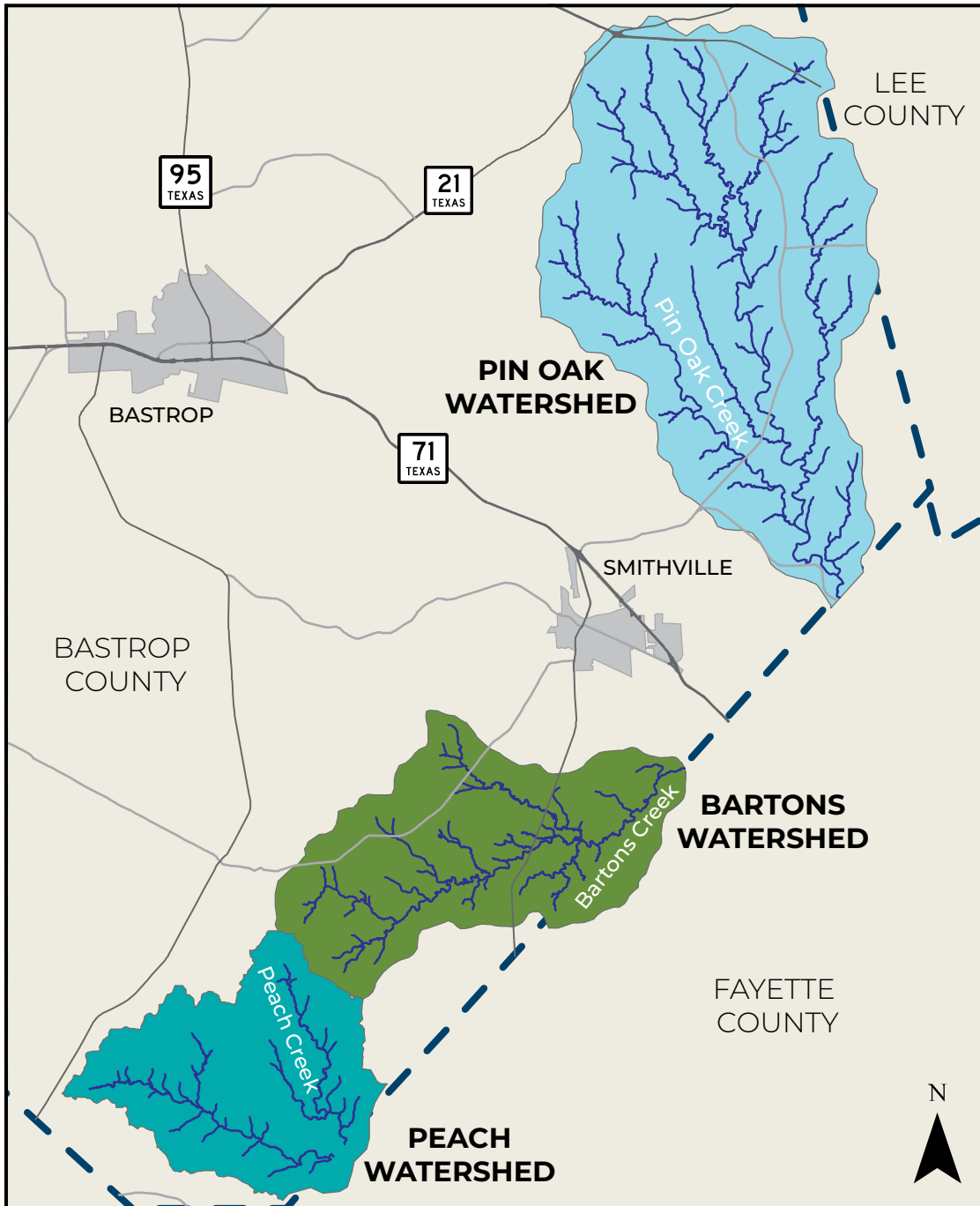

**Please join for an update on the on going floodplain study efforts being complete by Bastrop County with the awarded Texas Water Development Board Flood Infrastructure Fund Grant for the Pin Oak Creek, Bartons Creek, and Peach Creek watersheds shown to the left.**

The floodplain study has defined the existing condition flood risk within the Pin Oak Creek, Bartons Creek, and Peach Creek watersheds. These floodplain results have been used to identify areas with high risk of flooding during storm events. Public feedback is requested on the existing floodplain limits to help guide further efforts to identify proposed flood mitigation projects, with the goal of reducing flood risk and improving safety for residents in these watersheds.
