Probate Submission Docket

- Submission dockets are on most Thursday mornings. Neither parties nor counsel need to be present. Please email the coordinator for available dates.
- Only uncontested matters can be set for hearing by submission. Setting a case on the submission docket is a representation that there are no known contested issues.
- You must set your hearing for submission on a date after your posting notice has expired.
- E-file a sworn Proof of Death, any other relevant sworn testimony, and the Proposed Order to your case prior to the Thursday morning that your case is set.
- Verify that the attorney ad litem's report is on file, if applicable.
- After Judge Eskew has signed your Proposed Order, and it has been filed by the County Clerk's office (typically by Thursday afternoon), you may then file your sworn Oath and request your Letters, if applicable.
- Your Oath must be dated for the same day of the Order or later.
