**Directive #2 on Bastrop County COVID-19 Order #1A**

**Whereas**, in Bastrop County COVID-19 Order #1A, Section 3.6, all Bastrop County parks (Stoney Point, Cedar Creek, and the Nature Park on the Colorado River) were temporarily closed to the public, effective at 11:59 pm on April 9, 2020; and,

**Whereas**, by exercising social distancing and other measures promulgated by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) such as wearing a face covering when social distancing cannot be consistently maintained, the immediate risks of the spread of COVID-19 virus in open spaces such as parks can be effectively mitigated,

**Now Therefore**, I direct that all Bastrop County parks are open to the public, subject to recommended CDC social distancing guidelines, effective at 11:59 pm on April 21, 2020, through the term of Bastrop County COVID-19 Order #1A. Playground facilities and other park improvements will remain closed to public use.

Other provisions of Bastrop County COVID-19 Order #1A are not changed by this Directive.
