BASTROP COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 3 ORDER LEVYING AD VALOREM TAX FOR 2020

WHEREAS, the BASTROP COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT No. 3, hereafter "the District", is a duly organized political subdivision of the State of Texas operating under the authority of Article XVI, Section 59, Texas Constitution, and Chapters 49 and 51, Texas Water Code, and

WHEREAS, Section 49.107, Texas Water Code, authorizes the District to levy and collect a tax for maintenance purposes, including funds for planning, maintaining, repairing, and operating all necessary plants, properties, facilities and improvements of the District and for paying the cost of proper services, engineering and legal fees, and organization and administrative expenses, and

WHEREAS, at an election held on August 10, 1991, the voters within the District authorized the District to levy annually a maintenance tax not to exceed \$2.00 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation on all taxable property within the District, and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration the District Board of Directors has determined that for the year 2020 a maintenance tax of \$_.\u224564 per \$100 valuation should be levied, and

WHEREAS, all necessary actions required by law as a prerequisite for the levy of the 2020 maintenance tax have been accomplished, including the publication of the required newspaper notice and the hearing to receive comments from the public regarding the levy of the 2020 maintenance tax,

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordered By the Board Of Directors Of Bastrop County Water Control and Improvement District No. 3 That:

- Section 1. Tax Roll. The tax roll presented to the Board of Directors, together with any supplements thereto, is hereby accepted and approved.
- Section 2. Adoption of Tax Rate. An ad valorem tax for maintenance purposes as authorized by Section 49.107, Texas Water Code at the rate set forth above is hereby levied on all taxable property within the District for the year 2020. The District Tax Assessor-Collector is hereby directed to issue the required tax notices and proceed with collection of the tax.
- Section 3. Tax Levy. There is hereby levied for the year 2020 upon all taxable property situated within the limits of the Bastrop County Water Control and Improvement District #3 on January 1, 2020, except so much thereof as may be exempted by the Constitution or laws of the State of Texas, a total tax of \$_.4084____ on each \$100 of assessed valuation on all taxable property.
- Section 4. Assessment and Lien. The Bastrop County Tax Assessor Collector is hereby authorized to assess and collect the taxes of said District employing the above tax rate. All taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which assessed, and the Bastrop County Tax Assessor Collector for and on behalf of the Bastrop County Water Control and Improvement District #3 shall by virtue of the tax rolls, fix and establish a lien by levying upon such taxable property for the payment of said taxes, penalty and interest; and the penalty and interest collected from such delinquent taxes shall be appropriated for the general fund of the District.
- Section 5. Severability. If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Order, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void, invalid, or unenforceable, neither the remaining portions of this Order nor their application to other persons or sets of circumstances shall be affected thereby, it being the intent of the Board in adopting this Order that no portion hereof or provision or regulation contained herein shall

become inoperative or fail by reason of any unconstitutionality, voidness, invalidity or unenforceability of any other portion hereof, and all provisions of this Order are declared to be severable for that purpose.

Section 6. Repealer. This Order shall be cumulative of all provisions of the orders and resolutions of the Bastrop County Water Control and Improvement District No. 3. All provisions of the orders and resolutions of the Bastrop County Water Control and Improvement District No. 3 in conflict with this Order by the same are hereby repealed and all other provisions of the orders and resolutions of the District not in conflict with the provisions of this Order shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Order shall become effective upon adoption.

Section 8. Open Meeting. The Board officially finds, determines, and declares that this ORDER was adopted at a duly called regular meeting of the Board and that a sufficient written notice of the date, hour, place, and subject of this meeting was posted at a place readily accessible and convenient to the public within the district and on the District's website for the time required by law preceding this meeting, as required by the Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, "Texas Public Information Act" and the Texas Water Code, and that this meeting has been open to the public as required by law at all times during which this ORDER and the subject matter hereof has been discussed, considered, and acted upon. The Board further ratifies, approves, and confirms such written notice and the contents and posting thereof.
