<u>SUMMARY</u>: Under the direct supervision of the Facility Maintenance Supervisor, this position performs and assists in all preventative maintenance, repairs, and additions to building, structures, and equipment assigned to BCSO. Supervises trusties in all aspects of maintenance and repair of heating and air conditioning, electrical, plumbing, roof and security systems.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED AND EXERCISED:

Receives supervision from the Facility Maintenance Sergeant, with further direction and guidance from the Jail Lieutenant.

Exercises no supervision.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following:

- 1. Supervises and assist in routine maintenance schedules for facility systems;
- 2. Maintains inventory of materials and equipment used in cleaning, maintenance and repair of facility grounds, and orders new stock as needed;
- 3. Assist in the coordination and supervision of all contract maintenance repairs and projects;
- 4. Performs any and all functions necessary to provide a safe living and working environment for staff and Inmates;
- 5. Supervises and assist in all Plumbing, Electrical, Structural, Locks, and CCTV repairs as necessary;

<u>OTHER FUNCTIONS</u>: Performs other job-related duties as directed by supervisor(s). **Regular attendance is considered an Essential Function of this job. Self-motivated and able to work unsupervised.

Must be able to work outside in extreme weather, prolong standing, climb ladders, and lift in excess of 50 lbs

Physical Demands:
